All Little Colts Are Invited. Children who attend our preschool on other days and times are also invited to attend for this event. Please bring in and drop off your child by 9:40 a.m. (no earlier please). Parents of children attending just for this event, please pick up your child promptly at 10:50 a.m. when the party has ended.

Parent Activities. Please help your child decorate a shoe or other type of box to put Valentine's Day cards in at school. This is a wonderful opportunity to spend quality parent/child time together. Be as creative as you like. Please make sure the opening on the box is big enough to fit large cards of all shapes and sizes. Place your child's picture on the front of the box to identify who they are giving a card to. Please send the box to school along with your child's Valentine's Day cards by February 11th. We will be delivering our Valentine's Day cards at the party



Your child will be delivering to each child's box. Because most of the children are not reading yet, we ask that your child refrain from writing a classmate's name on each card. Instead, we would appreciate that your child write his or her name on each card to designate whom that card is from. Then, your child will be able to deliver their own cards easily. We have 35 children currently enrolled in our school so please make at least 35 cards.
